Plug the included AC/DC power adapter into the DC POWER INPUT on the dock and an AC power outlet to power the dock.




Battery Backup


The battery backup is intended for short power outages only. The clock radio's primary functions cannot run off of the battery backup alone.



Clock and Sleep Timer

Setting the Clock

- If in radio mode, press and hold the Source/AI Off button to turn the unit off.
- Press and hold the Clock/Mem button until the display begins to blink, then release the button.
- 3. Press the **Hour** button to adjust the hour.

The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.

- 4. Press the **Min** button to adjust the minute.
- Press the Clock/Mem button to finish setting the time.

Setting the Sleep Timer

- 1. Press the **Snooze/Sleep** button repeatedly to set the sleep timer (90, 80, 70, 60, 50, 40, 30, 20, 10 min or OFF).
- Once the set sleep time has expired the clock radio will automatically power off.

Radio

Tuning the AM or FM Radio

- 1. Press the **Source/Al Off** button to turn the clock radio on.
- 2. Press the **Source/Al Off** button again to switch between the AM and FM radio mode.
- Press the Tun+ and Tunbuttons to adjust the radio to the desired frequency.
- Press and hold the Tun+ and Tun- buttons to search for the next available frequency.
- Press the Vol+/- buttons to adjust the volume.
- Press and hold the Source/Al Off to turn the radio off.

Saving a Station as a Preset

- Follow the instructions for <u>Tuning the AM or FM Radio.</u>
- 2. Tune to the desired station.
- 3. Press and hold the **Clock/Mem** button to save the current radio station as a preset.

Tuning to a Preset Radio Station

- 1. Follow the instructions for <u>Tuning the Radio</u> and <u>Saving a</u> <u>Station as a Preset</u>.
- 2. Press the **Clock/Mem** button to cycle through preset radio stations.

Radio Reception

Adjust the position of the **FM Antenna** to improve FM radio reception.

An AM antenna is built into the clock radio. To improve AM radio reception, adjust the position of the clock radio.

Line Input

Using the Line Input

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the Line Input and the audio output on an MP3 player or other audio device.
- 2. Press the **Source/Al Off** to switch to Line in mode.

The display will show "AU"

 Use the native controls on the connected MP3 player or other audio source to play your audio through the unit. The volume buttons on the unit will not function in line in mode, so it is necessary to use the controls on the native device.

When not in use, make sure to disconnect the 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

Alarm

Setting the Alarm

- If in radio mode, press and hold the Source/AI Off button to turn the unit off.
- 2. Press the Al1 or Al2 button.
- 3. Press the **Hour** button to adjust the hour.

The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.

4. Press the **Min** button to adjust the minute.

The Alarm 1 or Alarm 2 indicator will come on.

- 5. Press the **Al1** or **Al2** buttons repeatedly to switch between Radio, Buzzer or off.
- 6. Once the set alarm time is reached, the alarm will sound.

To set the other alarm, follow the above steps and choose the alarm not currently set.

Cancelling the Alarm

- 1. Follow the instructions for Setting the Alarm.
- Press the Al1 or Al2 buttons repeatedly until the indicator is no longer lit.

After the alarm sounds:

Snooze and Alarm Reset

delay the alarm for an additional 9 minutes.

OR

Press the **Source/AI Off** button to turn the alarm off until the set alarm time is reached again.
