



Battery Power

Insert 2 AAA batteries (not included) into the BATTERY COMPARTMENT.



CLOCK, ALARM, AND RADIO

Setting the Clock

- 1. Press the Time/Mem button.
- 2. Press the Tune +/- buttons to adjust the hour.
- 3. Press the **Time/Mem** button.
- Press the Tune +/- buttons to adjust the minute. The AM or PM INDICATOR on the display will illuminate when the time is set in the AM or PM.
- 5. Press the **Time/Mem** button to finish setting the clock.

Setting the Alarm

- Press and hold the Alarm On/Off button until the display begins to flash.
- 2. Press the Tune +/- button to adjust the hour.
- 3. Press the Alarm On/Off button.
- Press the Tune +/- buttons to adjust the minute. The AM or PM INDICATOR on the display will illuminate when the time is set in the AM or PM.
- 5. Press the **Alarm On/Off** button to finish setting the clock.
- 6. Press the **Alarm On/Off** button to turn the alarm on. The ALARM INDICATOR on the display will illuminate when the alarm is turned on.
- 7. After the alarm sounds, press the **Power** button to turn the alarm off.

Saving a Station as a Preset

- 1. Once on a desired frequency, press and hold the **Time/Mem** button.
- 2. Use the Tune +/- to set the desired preset number.
- 3. Press the **Time/Mem** button to finish setting the station as a preset.

Tuning to a Preset Radio Station

Press the Time/Mem button to cycle through your preset radio stations.
