## **Getting Started**

Before we start lets make sure we have the correct mount and all the required tools and hardware to complete the installation.

- The TV is a Flat Panel TV between 37" 80" and weighs no more than 130lbs.
- The Wall the TV will be mounted on is either concrete or dry wall with wood studs.
- You have all of the following tools:


If you answer "Yes" to all the questions above then you are ready to begin the TV Mount installation!

#### Step 2A: Install Wall Plate on Drywall with Wood Stud Note: For Concrete skip to Step 2B

 Use the stud finder to locate 2 studs. Then draw a vertical line marking the center of the stud.

2 Level the Wall plate Template(C) And align it with the center Of the studs. Make 4 Pencil marks to indicate where to drill.





Caution: The minimum size of the woodstud must be 2"x 4" and the thickness of the drywall must not exceed 5/8".

#### Step 2B: Install Wall Plate on Concrete

- 1 Level the wall plate template(**C**) and make 6 marks with pencil to show where to drill the pilot holes.
- 2 Remove the Wall plate template (C) and drill the pilot holes with a 3/8" drill bit.
- (3) Insert the anchors(W-B) into the 6 pilot holes, tap with a hammer, insert 2 bolts(W-A) on the top of pilot holes and leave 5mm length by tighten.

#### Tools Required:



Caution: The minimum depth of the concrete must be 8".


Do not drill pilot holes into the mortar between the concrete.

## **Parts & Hardware**

3 Remove the wall plate Template(C) and drill the pilot holes with a 3/16" drill bit.

4 Align the pilot holes and insert 2 bolts(**W-A**) on the top of pilot holes and leave 5mm length by tighten.

4 Hang the wall plate(A) on the fixed bolts and align the wall plate with the pilot holes.


5 Insert the rest of the 4 bolts (W-A) through the washers (W-C) and tighten all 6 bolts (W-A).

#### Step 1: Attach Mounting Bracket to TV

 Check what screw size will fit in your TV. (M-A,M-B, M-C,M-D,M-E)


Note: If Your TV has a curved back you may need to use longer screws with spacers( M-G,M-H)

2 Align the mounting bracket onto the back of the TV and install with the appropriate hardware and tighten.

**Note:** If the back of your TV is curved, use the appropriate Combination of spacers to level the mounting brackets.









- 5 Hang the wall plate(**A**) on the fixed bolts and align the wall plate with the pilot holes
- 6 Insert the rest of the 2 bolts (W-A) through the washers (W-C) and tighten all 4 bolts (W-A).







## Step 3: Hang Your TV



- After the TV is hanging properly on the wall mount.
- 3 The TV stop push up on the TV PLATE and alignment hole, install the two screws(**D**) and tighten.
